5. Explain what Paul means by “redeeming the time” or “making the most of every opportunity” in verse 6.
6. What is important about the way we speak to others? Explain. (verse 6)
7. How does Paul feel about Tychicus? Explain what he means. (verse 7)

8. Why was he sent to Colosse? (verse 8)

9. Who is coming with him and what is said about him? (verse 9)

10. Who is Paul's fellow prisoner and what do we know about him? (verse 10)

11. Tell all you can about Mark. (verse 11)

12. Who were the only Jews with Paul during his imprisonment?

13. How is Epaphras' prayer life described and for what did he pray? (verse 12)

14. Why does Paul vouch for Epaphras? (verse 13)

15. Who else with Paul and what do we know about them? (verse 14)

16. What was to be done with this epistle and others Paul wrote? (verse 16) Why?

17. What message is given to Archippus? Do we know who he is? (verse 17)

18. What is Paul's final statements and what do they mean? (verse 18)
