- c. How can this be explained?
- d. What is the keyword in these verses (see also Jude 4)?

II. The Predictions of the Apostles (17-19)?

- a. Where is the prediction given in verse 18 found also in Scripture?

III. Solution - Actions to be Taken

- a. How can we counter these people, and keep from becoming one of them?
- b. What are the differences between the groups listed in verse 22, and how are our actions to differ?

IV. Doxology

- a. How does verse 24 compare to verse 21? What false doctrine can be countered using verses 21 and 24?

V. Bonus

Jude has been described by commentators as a book of "threes". For example, he addresses the book to 1) "those who are called", 2) "beloved in God the Father", and 3) "kept for Jesus Christ". There are examples of this throughout the book. What "threes" do you find?
