- f. What was Peter reaction to the great catch of fish?
- g. What did Jesus tell Peter he would do from now on?
- h. List the advantages and disadvantages that Peter might have considered.
- i. Why did Peter agree? Is there any similarity in this and putting out to fish again?

2. Saturday (Sabbath) morning

- a. Read Mark 1:21-31
- b. Where did Jesus go on the Sabbath and what did he do there?
- c. How did the people view what he was doing?

- d. How was the service interrupted?
- e. How did Jesus restore order?
- f. What was the reaction of the people to his healing this man?
- g. Where did Jesus go after the synagogue service and what occurred there?
- h. What do we learn about Peter from this event?

3.Saturday Evening (after Sabbath)

- a. Read Mark 1:32-34
- b. Who were brought to Jesus after the Sabbath ended?
- c. How many were present and what did Jesus do?

4. Early Sunday Morning

- a. Read Mark 1:35-39
- b. What did Jesus do early on Sunday morning?
- c. Who found him and what did they tell Jesus?
- d. What do you suppose the crowds wanted Jesus to do?
- e. What did Jesus insist that they do, and why did he want to do that?
